What is on offer:

There are three session available for you to book individually, as a package or as one workshop which will include an overview on all topics.

The session incorporates a range of active learning methods to identify and address sensitive issues and to facilitate positive discussions. Who is this for?

The session is designed for a small group of girls. Ideally the group would number 5 - 10 and the girls would be 11 to 18 years old. We would be willing to discuss other arrangements, but please note that this is not designed as a large scale presentation. The sessions has been thoughtfully put together to ensure that it can accommodate the different learning needs of the participants in order to remove any barriers to learning.

Timing:

The sessions are designed to last 2 hours. It could be delivered in 1.5 hours although this would obviously involve curtailing some activities.
